### **SUMMARY OF POSITION**

Yellow Quill First Nation is seeking a Land Based Teacher position at Nawigizigweyas Education Centre for the 2025-2026 school year. NEC is a K-12 school with a great team to ensure the students are successful.

### **Duties and responsibilities:**

This position is designed for an individual who is committed to integrating Indigenous knowledge, culture, and language into the curriculum, while fostering a deep connection to the land among students. The Land-Based Teacher will work collaboratively with students, families, and community members to create a holistic learning environment that respects and honors Sauteaux traditions.

### **Key Responsibilities:**

- Develop and implement a land-based curriculum that includes all core areas of study that incorporates Sauteaux culture, history, and language.
- Facilitate outdoor learning experiences that engage students in traditional practices such as hunting, fishing, foraging, and cultural ceremonies.
- Collaborate with local Elders and knowledge keepers to enrich educational programs and provide mentorship to students.
- Foster a safe and inclusive classroom environment that promotes respect, resilience, and personal growth.
- Assess and evaluate student progress through observation and meaningful assessments aligned with both educational standards and community values.
- Organize and lead community events, workshops, and field trips that enhance students' understanding of their cultural heritage and the natural environment.
- Communicate effectively with parents and guardians to keep them informed about students' progress and opportunities for involvement in the educational process.
- Stay current with best practices in land-based education and Indigenous pedagogy to continually improve teaching methods.
