

Operational Support

- Provide technical and logistical support to the Food Security Coordinator and garden team as needed (without being part of daily garden operations).
- Assist with moving materials, soil, compost, lumber, and other supplies.
- Support seasonal setup and shutdown of food production sites.
- Help identify improvements to systems, workflows, and infrastructure.

Safety & Reporting

- Follow all OHS safety procedures and promote safe operation of tools and equipment.
- Report equipment issues, hazards, or project delays to the Food Security Manager.
- Keep simple records of maintenance, repairs, and project tasks as requested.

EDUCATION, REQUIREMENTS, and SKILLS:

- Ability to perform physical work, including digging, weeding, lifting, bending, squatting, and standing for extended periods.
- Willingness to work outdoors most days in a variety of weather conditions.
- Interest in learning about gardening, food production, and food preservation using organic and sustainable methods.
- Desire to contribute to community health, wellness, and food security.
- Willingness to learn, take direction, and develop new skills.
- Ability to work both independently and as part of a team.
- Good communication skills and willingness to ask questions when unsure.
- Ability to complete basic timesheets and simple work reports.
- Valid Class 5 driver's licence is an asset but not necessary.
- Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Check required.
