The Land Based Coordinator will co-deliver programs in local outdoor settings in a way that honors Indigenous Cree values and ways of learning. The programming will provide a culture-based approach to learning and activities.

Be able to plan, implement and report on a land-based program for Pre K to grade 8

Successful experience with a land-based program

*Cree language an asset

Be physically active and able to meet the demands of all year-round outdoor activities

Be innovative and culturally sensitive as needed

- take initiative
- willingness to be part of a collaborative team
- positive professional/personal attributes.
- creative and independent work skills.
- flexibility in the workday is necessary to perform the required duties and Responsibilities.
- access to a private vehicle is required and submission of a Drivers Abstract.
- knowledge and understanding of First Nation Communities and their culture.
